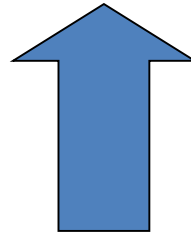

(80%)**

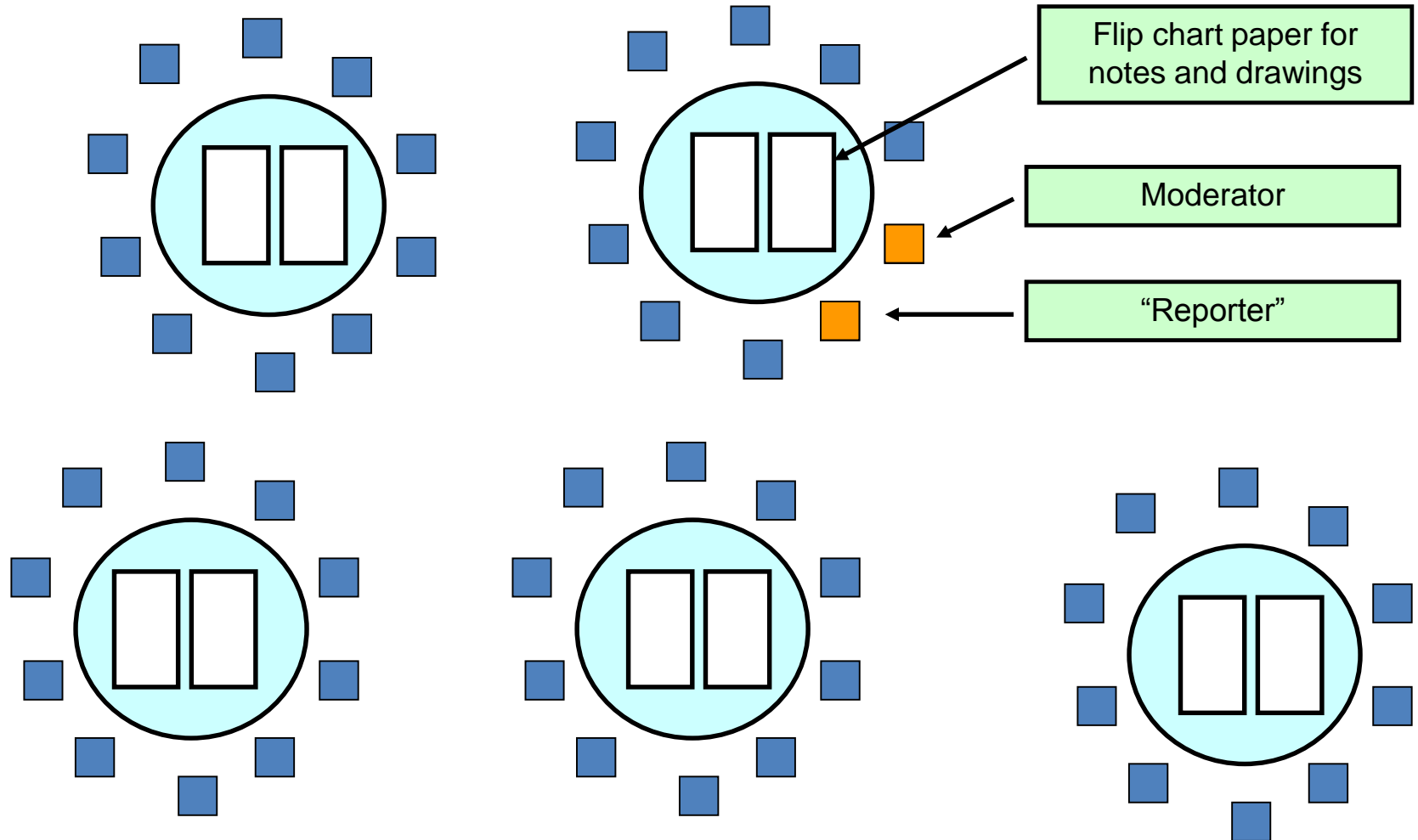
Common framework
