# TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE QUARTERLY BULLETIN OF COCOA STATISTICS ISSUED BY THE INTERNATIONAL COCOA ORGANIZATION (ICCO)

#### 1. Purpose and Scope

These Terms and Conditions govern the purchase, use, quotation, citation, and publication of the *Quarterly Bulletin of Cocoa Statistics* (QBCS) issued by the Secretariat of the International Cocoa Organization (ICCO). By purchasing or accessing the QBCS in any format (online, digital, printed or combined.), the subscriber agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

# 2. Legal Basis and Data Sources

The QBCS is issued by the Secretariat of the International Cocoa Organization (ICCO) in accordance with article 30 of the *International Cocoa Agreement, 2010, and any subsequent Agreement thereof.* The statistical data published in the Bulletin is compiled from reports supplied directly to the Organization by member and non-member countries and from other official sources of the countries concerned. Where necessary, provisional estimates, based on reported exports and/or imports, are provided.

The ICCO Secretariat gratefully acknowledges the co-operation and assistance of member and non-member governments, inter-governmental and governmental bodies, public and private sector statistical organizations, trade and industry associations, market and research institutions and private companies.

## 3. Disclaimer of Liability

The ICCO and its Secretariat make every effort to ensure the accuracy, reliability, and timeliness of the data contained in the OBCS. However:

- The ICCO does not guarantee that the data are free from errors or omissions and accepts no
  responsibility or liability for any inaccuracies, misinterpretations, or decisions made based on
  the information provided.
- The ICCO shall not be held liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, or special damages arising from the use of, or inability to use, the QBCS or its contents.
- Users acknowledge that data may be revised in subsequent issues as new information becomes available.

## 4. Interpretation and Revisions

Caution should be exercised when interpreting the data contained in the QBCS. Figures and methodologies are subject to review and revision without prior notice. The ICCO is not obligated to notify subscribers of such revisions individually.

Upon receipt of a completed order form, an invoice will be issued. The requested publication(s) will be delivered once payment is confirmed in the ICCO bank account.

# 8. Coverage and Historical Data

- Subscribers typically receive access to up to 15 years of historical data, subject to availability.
- The detailed quarterly breakdown of data is limited to a maximum of two countries and does not extend beyond the 15-year window.

#### 9. Dispute

Should any dispute arise between the client and the contractor, both parties shall do their best to resolve it amicably.
